



Spring is here! Get your landscape into full bloom this spring. The weather on the Front Range has finally warmed a bit and now is the time to get outside and assess what you would like to accomplish in your landscape this season. Take a walk around your property and look for damaged trees and shrubs. Prune out “winter kill” as soon as the plant has leafed out. These are simply areas of the plant that will not rejuvenate due to harsh winter freezing conditions.

Perennials should be cut back before they start to sprout new growth. It is much easier to do now than to navigate tender new shoots while cutting things back. Remove any dead limbs from trees using a saw or loppers. For larger branches, have a professional do the work. Clean out any remaining leaves and debris that have blown into beds after your fall cleanup... you DID complete the fall cleanup, right? If not, you may have more work ahead of you than you think!
